An attractive and characterful 1930s three-bedroom detached family home, occupying a generous plot along the popular Lower Luton Road, ideally positioned between Wheathampstead and Harpenden. While the property would benefit from modernisation internally, it offers exceptional scope for enhancement and extension (subject to planning consents), presenting an ideal prospect for purchasers wishing to create a bespoke family home. The ground floor is spacious and versatile. To the rear, an L-shaped sitting and dining room extends over 20 feet, with views across the garden and patio doors opening onto the terrace, perfect for entertaining. A separate front sitting room provides a cosy retreat, while the kitchen is adjacent to the dining area. The ground floor also includes a shower room and entrance hall. Upstairs, the property offers three bedrooms; the principal with an en suite bathroom. Outside, the impressive garden features flowerbeds, mature planting, and seating areas. A driveway provides ample parking leading to the divided garage.
