Dating back to the 17th century this stunning two-bedroom home is part of what was once the Princes Head Public House that remained so until 1914.

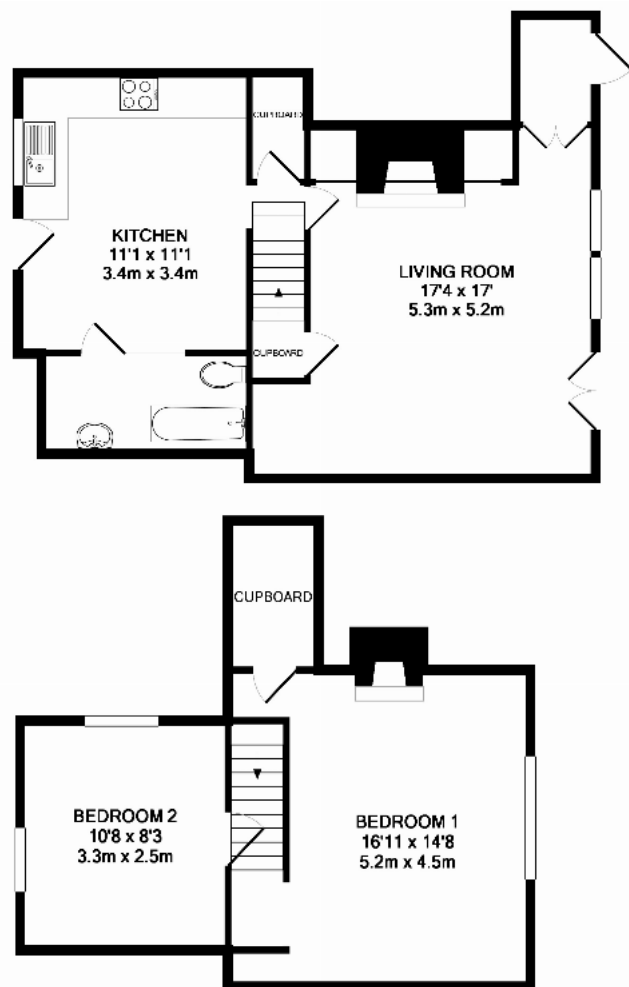
Description
